Principal Dr. Madhuri Khambete welcomed all the Governing Body members present for the meeting in person and online.

Following points were discussed and decisions were taken in the meeting:

Point No. 1] To confirm the minutes of the previous Governing Body meeting held on 20th March, 2023.

Discussion: Dr. Anand Bewoor read the draft minutes which were circulated to the members before the meeting.

Point No. 2] To review NEP implementation at CCEW, Pune.

Discussion:

Dr. Anand Bewoor, Dean academic gave information about the guidelines from UGC and Govt. of Maharashtra for Autonomous Institutes. As per Maharashtra Govt. GR dated 4th July, 2023 it is mandatory to implement NEP 2020 from the A.Y. 2023-24. He added that as per the guidelines and GR, curriculum structure has been prepared which is approved by Academic Council.

Discussion:

- (i) Principal told that permission has been granted by Governing Body in the previous meeting to increase intake of B.Tech. Information Technology from 60 to 120. However due to technical problems college could not apply to AICTE for the same.
- (ii) Dr. Madhuri Khambete told that Computer Department wish to start M.Tech. Computer Engineering Program to enhance research activities.
- (iii)Dr. Anand Bewoor said that considering the current trend BoS and Academic Council have advised to change M.Telch. Mechanical Engineering specialization to Robotics & Artificial Intelligence.
