The following points were discussed and decisions were taken in the meeting:

, 0	To confirm the minutes of the previous Governing Body meeting held on 12^{th} December, 2023.
Discussion:	Dr. Anand Bewoor read the draft minutes which were circulated to the members before the meeting.

Body meeting held on previous Governing Minutes of the Decision : 12th December, 2023 were confirmed.

Point No. 2] To approve the budget for the Financial Year 2024-25.

Discussion:

- The proposed financial budget was presented. The Principal told that only tuition fees are considered as a source of income. Recurring grants and specific donations are not considered in income as these are uncertain.

 - (ii) Exchange of faculty members and administrative staff.
 - (iii) Exchange of undergraduate and graduate students.
 - (iv) Exchange of research outcomes, academic publications, other academic information, and other academic & education exchange programs.
 - Under this MoU, 3+1 program from Hiroshima University has been announced at CCEW and one student application is in progress.

Decision:

Governing Council members appreciated the efforts taken for the MoUs for our students with internationally reputed universities.

Point No. 7] To inform about feedback on the internship program.

Discussion:

Prof. Amit Rajurkar, T&P Officer presented the feedback on internships in the form of responses from nearly 500 plus students, who had undergone 6 months of internships from June to December 2023.
