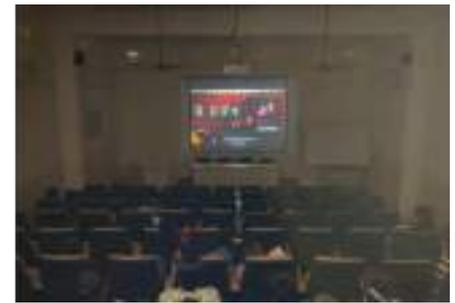
## EVENTS

TED is a global non-profit platform dedicated to spreading impactful ideas through talks that cover a wide range of fields including technology, entertainment, design, science, humanities, business, and development. To extend this vision, TED introduced TEDx, a series of independently organized events that provide communities with a TED-like experience under the philosophy of “ideas worth spreading.”

TEDxCCOEW, affiliated with MKSSS's Cummins College of Engineering for Women, Pune, carries forward this mission by hosting events that encourage growth, inspire innovation, and promote community engagement. While independently organized, these events adhere to TED's guidelines to maintain quality and impact. The core objective is to bring together bright minds, foster meaningful connections, and create a platform where transformative ideas can be shared and celebrated.

## EVENTS

TEDxCCOEW conducted their first event of this current academic year: **Kairos**.

Kairos signifies the perfect, opportune moment to take action or create impact. In classical rhetoric and philosophy, Kairos refers to the right time or critical moment when something meaningful should be said or done.



### Kairos Event Recap

On February 22, 2025, TEDxCCOEW hosted an inspiring TEDx event, “Kairos”, with a diverse lineup of speakers who enthralled the audience with their unique insights and experiences. The event began with a stimulating talk by Pranjal Priya who shares how overcoming self-doubt and taking action shaped her journey. At just 19, Pranjal was the runner-up in Miss Universe India. She talks about her RAF approach – Research, Action, and Faith. She demonstrates how excessive thinking breeds fear while taking steps and action builds confidence. Her journey showcases that a “right time” is nothing but an illusion.

Following her, Kedar Patankar delivered a thought-provoking talk, challenging us to rethink how we experience life. He questions conventional notions of fulfillment and success. He presents us with a straightforward technique– relationships, career, health, creativity, etc. are equal sized boxes that make up our lives. Along with personal boxes, we possess universal boxes as well, including relationships, giving back and gratitude. Each box holds equal importance and necessity. It is up to us how we expand them and check them off everyday. In his talk, he explores the “Fast-Forward Technique” - a mindset that helps embrace life's unpredictability by focusing on maximizing experiences rather than seeking validation. He discusses the impact of Trash Talk, his eight-year heritage conservation initiative, while offering insights from his varied experiences as an engineer, author, and history geek.



## EVENTS

The event continued with Sunil Limaye, an IFS officer, discussing the coexistence of humans and wildlife. He dispels common misconceptions and fears about wildlife, drawing from his extensive experience. He has held important roles such as Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Wildlife) and the Chief Wildlife Warden of Maharashtra. Despite his retirement, he remains an active member of the Supreme Court's Central Empowered Committee, advocating for the protection of wildlife. He highlights that conservation is not only a governmental obligation but also one that is shared.



Rakhi Pal took the stage with her captivating talk challenging the traditional idea that happiness is something we chase. She believes it is something we create through the choices we make, our consistency and our grit. Success isn't reaching the final destination, but it is the process of building a life that aligns with who you are. As the founder of EventBee, Rakhi shares the lessons she's learnt in her entrepreneurship journey as a woman in leadership.

The concluding talk was delivered by Pandit Ramdas Palsule, an acclaimed tabla maestro. He takes us into the world of Indian classical music, talking about the essence of Swara (musical notes), Laya (timing), and Gati (rhythmic movement), while shedding light on why Raya has no true counterpart in western music. Through a masterful exploration of Taal, he demonstrates how the tabla evolves linearly and cyclically, blending into genres seamlessly.

#### Aptitude Test Series(ongoing)

This initiative aimed to prepare students for competitive exams, internship placements, and technical assessments by simulating real-world problem-solving scenarios. The tests covered a range of topics, including quantitative aptitude, logical reasoning, and analytical thinking, enabling participants to refine their problem-solving skills. Through consistent participation, students improved their ability to approach complex challenges efficiently while also gaining confidence in tackling high-pressure assessments. Beyond academic benefits, the series fostered a spirit of competitiveness and self-improvement. Regular performance tracking allowed participants to identify areas for growth, and the structured format helped build consistency in practice.

## Vision

## Mission

## EVENTS

### Orientation

Team Loop held an orientation session for FY and SY students on 8th October 2024 to provide an overview of club activities and guide them in starting their coding journey. A 'DSA from Scratch' roadmap with resources, tips, and logic-building steps was also shared with first-year students.



### Cipher 7.1

Cipher 7.1, held in December, helps experienced coders enhance problem-solving skills and get familiar with industry coding platforms. Over 200 students from First to Third year participated, with winners receiving certificates to recognize their achievements and motivate others.

### Codigo 3.1

Codigo is a 3-round coding contest with online and offline events: Round 1 – online quiz, Round 2 – offline Hackerrank contest, Round 3 – offline mock interview (HR + Technical). Participants selected in Round 2 and winners from each year received certificates. The event drew over 200 students and received a great response.



## EVENTS

### Buffer 6.0

Buffer is a Data Structures and Algorithms project series where students participate as mentees in teams of 2-4 under the guidance of senior mentors. The activity provides experience with real-world applications and coding, and winners receive certificates. Buffer 6.0 has 170+ team registrations and runs from 1st March to 19th April 2025.



### DSA-Nexus

DSA NEXUS, a Data Structures and Algorithms competition during Innovation 2025, was open to all colleges. Round 1 had MCQs and coding questions, shortlisting 87 teams. Round 2 featured a Mystery Box challenge and Code Relay, while Round 3 was an ideathon where teams solved real-life problems using 3-4 data structures. The event tested practical DSA skills, offered a ₹20,000 prize pool, and all participants received certificates.

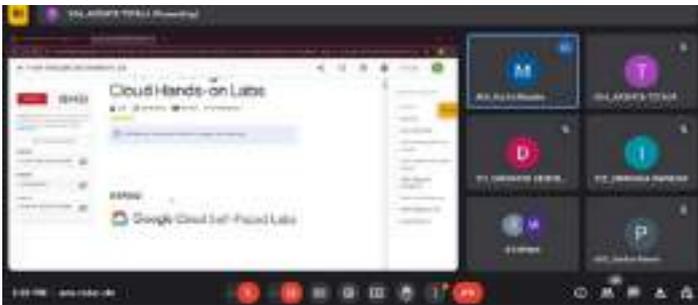

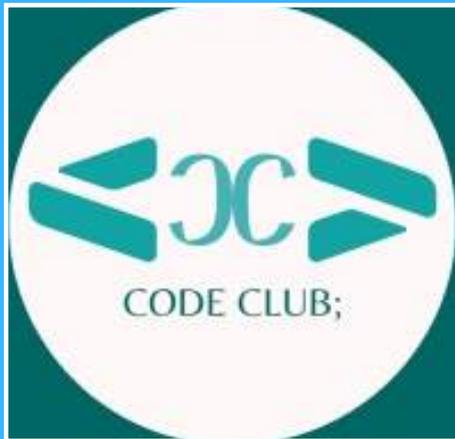

### PROBLEM OF THE WEEK SERIES - 12 WEEKS MARATHON

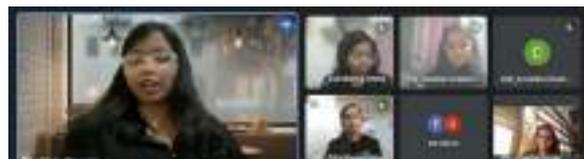
