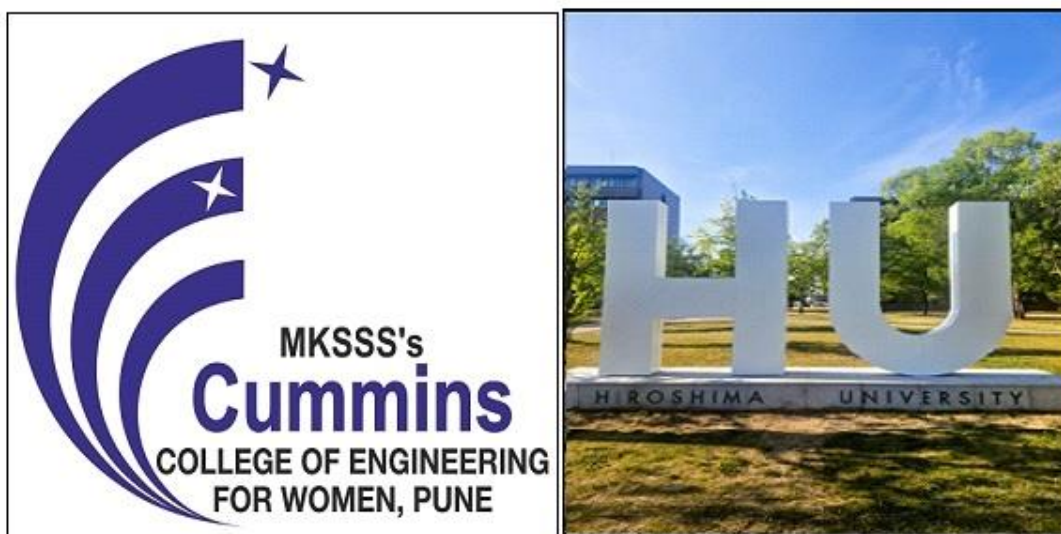




CCEW, Pune, Students Awarded Prestigious JASSO Scholarship at Hiroshima University, Japan
